CREW NETWORK DELEGATE REPORT

In a time of market uncertainty professionals look for answers and that's exactly what the 2007 CREW Network Convention & Marketplace delivered. With nearly 900 commercial real estate professionals converging in Denver, Colorado, October 3-6, attendees were provided with economic updates and forecasts, revised investment strategies to successfully navigate the current debt market "hiccup," real estate financing opportunities and more.

Convention sessions focused on emerging trends and new technologies in real estate, the increasing popularity of mixed-use developments, the impact of water rights on future developments, and opportunities associated with the emerging Latino market. Professional development was also a central component.

In CREW Network's recent study *Minding the Gap*, recommendations for overcoming the compensation discrepancies that currently exist between women and men call for women to arm themselves with better knowledge about market compensation practices. Supporting this recommendation, CREW delivered a comprehensive session focused on providing market compensation statistics and strategies for achieving maximum worth. According to the authors of *Women Don't Ask*, by neglecting to negotiate her starting salary for her first job, a woman may sacrifice over half a million dollars in lost earnings by the end of her career.

On Thursday, November 15th, TCREW organized a bus tour of the new convention center in downtown Raleigh. Fifty plus members and guests gathered on the 23rd floor of 2 Hannover street above Mulkey Engineers offices, providing an opportunity to visit and network before and after the bus tour. AT Work Interiors sponsored the event. Rocky Top hospitality provided a sumptuous array of food that included warm appetizers served by a gracious staff. The buffet table included an array of cheese, fruit and dessert finger foods. Our convention center hosts included Dave Benevides, Capital City Connectors Chairman George Douglas, City of Raleigh Construction Management Mickey Barbour, Raleigh Convention Center Facilities Manager and Mara Craft Convention Sales Manager who toured groups of 25 around and under the new building in the midst of construction.

Plans for the center include 500,000 square feet of elegant, functional space -- a spectacular exhibit hall, 20 meeting rooms, open reception areas and a stunning 32,617-sq.-ft. ballroom that will divide into three separate rooms. Visitors will be welcomed into a grand lobby of dazzling floor-to-ceiling windows. Open and airy, the 4,100-square-foot, street-level mezzanine will overlook the exhibit hall and provide easy access to all other areas of the center and the attached Marriott Hotel. Granite details including a "shimmer wall" that will display lights of changing colors. There are casual seating arrangements and a gracious reception area that will create the ideal spot to mix and mingle before or after events.
